



COVID-19 Vaccine Information Sheet

Please read this document completely.

The information on this sheet will help you safely receive the COVID vaccine.

Should you schedule a COVID-19 vaccination appointment?

There are some people who should delay vaccination or not be vaccinated. If you meet one of the criteria below you should not schedule an appointment and, if you have questions, should contact the Enloe Command Center:

1. You have had any vaccine in the last 14 days.
2. You are sick with a fever or cough.
3. You have been asked to quarantine or isolate because of COVID-19 disease or exposure.
4. You have been previously diagnosed COVID and have received a passive immunity infusion in the last 90 days.
5. You have had an allergic reaction to any components of a COVID vaccine.

What to expect when you schedule your vaccination appointment.

Be aware that you will be asked the following questions. Please be prepared to provide this information.

1. Your race.
2. Your ethnicity
3. If you have a history of anaphylaxis for any reason. If you do have this history you will be observed for 30 minutes after your vaccination rather than the standard 15 minutes.

What to expect at your COVID vaccination appointment.

1. You should not arrive for your vaccination appointment sooner than 5 minutes before you are scheduled.
2. You must wear a mask and maintain 6 feet from others whenever possible.
3. You may need to stand in a line. Please bring warm clothes and an umbrella.
4. You will be asked to complete a form and will go through a brief check-in process.
5. You will be given the vaccine, a white card with proof of vaccination and a sticker for your work badge.
6. You will be observed for 15 minutes after your vaccination, as required by the CDC.

Your second COVID vaccination appointment.

During your first appointment your second appointment will be scheduled. The date for your second appointment will be recorded on your white COVID vaccination card. The period of time between your first and second vaccine appointments varies depending on which vaccine you receive.

What If you experience a reaction to the vaccine?

All are encouraged to report vaccine reactions to the VAERS system, which can be found at <https://vaers.hhs.gov/>.

Additionally, any reaction that requires medical attention should also be reported to the Enloe Command Center.
